

PERFORMANCE APPRENTICESHIP SCHEME AUDITION NOTICE



Earthfall is looking to appoint three apprentice dancers in September / October 2014 for the rehearsal and development period of their new production 'Stories from a Crowded Room'.

The apprentice dancers must be classified as soon-to-be or recent graduate (completing studies after June 2013). They should be someone that will benefit from the experience of working with a professional company during the creative process of making new work.

The apprentices will work alongside the company to directly contribute artistically, and will develop their technique through Earthfall's ethos and methodologies.

They will have to commit to the entire four week rehearsal period, and will be required to attend all company classes and rehearsals during this process. There will be the opportunity for feedback from the artistic team, and the potential for further involvement with the company. The rehearsal process will take place in Cardiff in from Monday 8th September, to Saturday 4th October 2014.

This is a paid position of £300 per week and would best suit contemporary dancers who are looking to further their training, and gain professional experience.

An audition will be held on Saturday 28th June, in Cardiff.
